High school students in Simcoe County will now be learning how to save a life. The ACT CPR and Defibrillator Training Program was launched on Friday. The program will see more than 65 hundred Grade nine students from 24 public and catholic high schools learn the life saving techniques.

The schools involved include those in Stayner, Collingwood, Midland, Barrie, Alliston, Penetanguishene, Orillia and Innisfil.

72 phys ed teachers have been trained to instruct their students and 480 mannequins and 52 defibrillator training units are being donated to the schools.
