



Teachers to Train Students in CPR

Nine teachers from the Okanagan-Similkameen School District are empowering their students to save lives. Sandra Clarke with the ACT Foundation says the teachers are going through CPR training, which they will then pass on to their students. Clarke adds it's estimated only 15% of British Columbians know CPR. The Interior Savings Credit Union donated close to \$37,000 dollars to bring the ACT High School CPR Program to secondary schools in the Okanagan-Similkameen, Nicola-Similkameen and Kamloops/Thompson School Districts.
